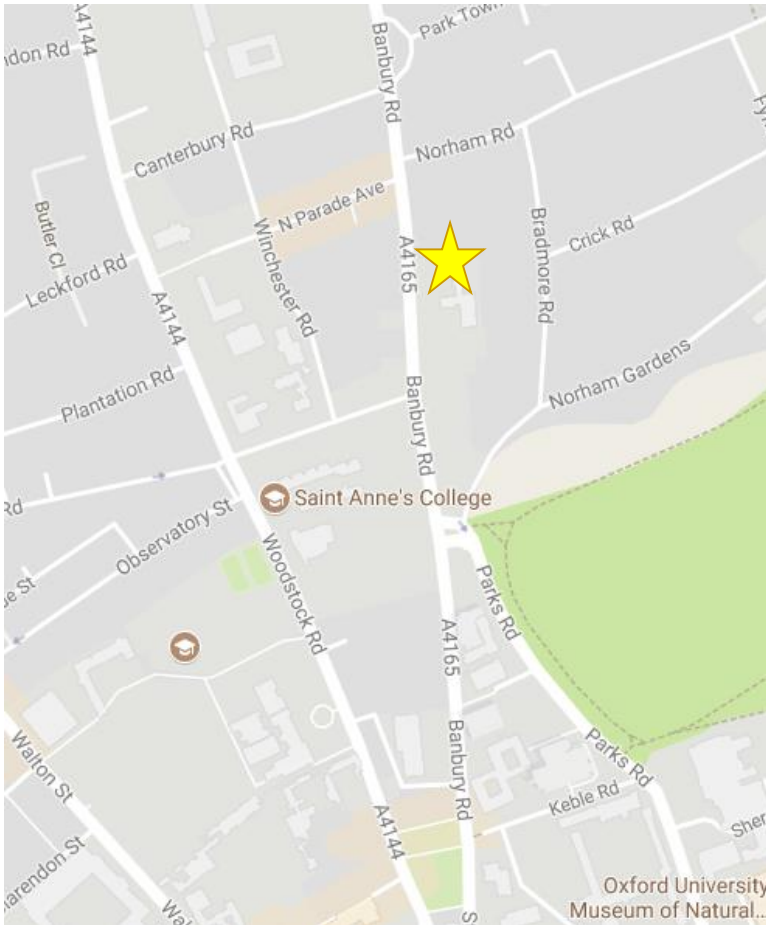

Please note that the building is accessed from Norham Road, and is located behind the Oxford English Language Centre. From the Banbury Road, turn into Norham Road and it's the second driveway on your right. Come to the white front door, shown on the photo below, and please call the phone number above for access (until the door access system is connected). Please note we are on the second floor and access is via stairs only.



How to get to Kellogg College:



By car

There is no public parking within Kellogg College grounds, however there are pay and display spaces on Norham Road and Bradmore Road. We recommend that drivers park at [Water Eaton Park and Ride](#) (OX2 8HA) and take the 500 bus, alighting at Park Town. Allow 20 mins for your bus journey.

By rail

From Oxford Parkway station: Take bus number 500 from outside the station, alighting at Park Town. Allow 20 mins for your bus journey.

From Oxford City station: Allow 10mins for a taxi ride, or 23 mins walking

By bus

Kellogg College is on the following bus routes: 2, 2A, 2B, 25A, 7, S5 and 500. Alight at Park Town.
